Attendance and Lateness

Our whole school attendance target is **97%**. We will be reviewing every child's attendance figures each week and shall closely monitor any child whose attendance has fallen below 96%. Of course we understand that when a child is very unwell they cannot attend but hope that these times will be very few as the year progresses. Any absence should be reported to the school office before 9am.

We ask that any doctors or dentist appointments are made outside of school hours wherever possible. If this is not possible we will need to see appointment cards or confirmation from any medical practice that an appointment has been made.

All children should arrive in school by **9am** ready for when lessons begin. The gates will be closed promptly at 9am and anyone arriving later than this will need to signed in the 'Late Arrivals' book located in the school office. We appreciate everyone's cooperation with this. Many thanks.
