Dear Parents and Carers,

As your child is now in Year 6 they have the exciting and possibly slightly daunting prospect of moving to a new school in September. In order to help them to be prepared for and excited by this change, we are running our annual open evening for Year 6 pupils and their parents on Thursday 7th October. Because of the pandemic, we are running this evening in a slightly different manner to previous years.

The school will be open for you and your child to look around and see a range of classrooms and different subject areas, with current Comberton pupils present to direct visitors around the school. There are a range of talks given by myself, the Head of Year and by our Head Prefect team and some current Year 7 pupils. Normally these would be in our Performance Hall, but to avoid crowds and help keep us all safe, this year these talks will be pre-recorded and will be available on the school website. In keeping with current national guidance, when members of the public meet in potentially busy indoor spaces, we are asked to wear face coverings. If you would like a "virtual tour" rather than an actual visit, all of our subject areas have produced virtual tours and there is a whole school tour, all of which is available on the above link. In order to reduce crowding we would appreciate if only one parent and a Year 6 child is brought on site if this is possible.

Please could you arrive on site for 6.30pm and could you leave by 7.45pm. Please be aware that car parking is always difficult on this very busy evening. When the school car park is full, it will be necessary for all the remaining visitors to park their cars on the school field. Please be aware that due to the volume of traffic, it may take some time to park.
